

VA's Blue Button Feature



VA's Blue Button feature makes accessing your VA medical records easy. It allows you to view and download your My HealthVet personal health information and share it with members of your health care team. You can create a single electronic file that includes all of your available personal health information and download as a PDF or text file. You can pick a date range and the information that you want to include to customize your report. If you are a VA patient and have a Premium My HealthVet account, this can include information from your VA Electronic Health Record and Military Service Information from the Department of Defense.

What Kind of Data is Available?

Listed below are the types of information (e.g., self-entered, VA Electronic Health Record, Department of Defense) that are available for you to access and download.

Self-entered Data

- Demographic Information
- Emergency Contact Information
- Health Care Providers
- Health Insurance
- Treatment Facilities
- Medical Conditions and Personal Medical History
- Medications, Herbals, and Supplements
- Allergies and Adverse Reactions
- Lab and Test Results
- Immunizations
- Vitals and Readings
- Family Health History (Self and Relatives)
- Military Health History
- Health Data (blood sugar, blood pressure, weight, etc.)
- My Goals: Current Goals and Completed Goals

VA Electronic Health Record Data

VA Allergies and VA Medication History require an Advanced account. All other items in this column require a Premium Account.

- VA Allergies
- VA Admissions and Discharges (Discharge Summary available 3 days after completed)
- VA Appointments (future)
- VA Appointments (past 2 years)
- VA Demographics
- VA Electrocardiogram (EKG) History (list of studies)
- VA Immunizations
- VA Laboratory Results: Chemistry/Hematology/Microbiology (3 day hold period applies)
- Notes (from 01 Jan 2013 forward , 3 day hold period applies)
- VA Laboratory Results: Chemistry/Hematology/Microbiology (available 3 days after verified)
- VA Medication History
- VA Notes (from 01 Jan 2013 forward, available 3 days after completed)
- VA Pathology Reports: Surgical Pathology, Cytology, Electron Microscopy (available 14 days after completed)
- VA Problem List (available 3 days after entered)
- VA Radiology Reports (available 3 days after completed)



How Do You Use VA Blue Button?

After you create a My HealthVet account and obtain a Premium My HealthVet account:

1. Login to your My HealthVet account.
2. Select Health Records from the Home Page.
3. You can then view, print or download your personal health information using the VA Blue Button feature.

If you have an upgraded account, you can also include information from your VA Electronic Health Record that is available in My HealthVet.
